

The 3rd Yuen Long District Outstanding Primary School Students Award (2008/2009)

Prize-giving Ceremony



The 3rd Yuen Long District Outstanding Primary School Students Award prize-giving ceremony was successfully held on 10th May, 2009 in Yuen Long Theater. The ceremony was graced by the presence of the chairman of New Territories Heung Yee Kuk, Mr. Lau Wong-fat, GBM, JP, member of the Executive Council and the Legislative Council. The presence of the honourable Mr. Tam Chi-yeun, JP, the Under Secretary for Constitutional and Mainland Affairs Bureau and Mr. Lai Tung-chai, Chief School Development Officer (YL) of EDB as guests of Honour, added prestige to the event.
