

2009/10 Statistical Project Competition (SPC)



Our students have been awarded rewards in the 2009/10 Statistical Project Competition (SPC) for Secondary School Students organized by the Hong Kong Statistical Society (HKSS) and the Education Bureau.

The SPC for Secondary School Students has been an annual event of the HKSS and the Education Bureau since 1986/1987. The objectives of the SPC are to enhance the interest of secondary school students in research methods, statistics and statistical techniques; to encourage students to understand their community through scientific and statistical methods; and to arouse students' social awareness and sense of civic responsibility. The SPC is divided into two sections, namely Junior Section for Secondary 3 to 5 students and Senior Section for Secondary 6 and 7 students.

This year, the SPC received 224 projects. After intense competition, students from our school were selected, out of over one thousand entries, to the final. Through their outstanding performance, they were awarded First Runner-up in the Senior Section in addition to Distinguished Prizes in the Junior and Senior Sections.

Chan Wai Lung, Hung Wing Tung, Lee Yu Yan Carmen, Lo Ka Po and Lo Lok from S.6, whose project was titled "The Path to Medicine" (「醫」條路點行?), received First Runner-up in the Senior Section, and was awarded a trophy, certificates and book coupons worth \$1000. Also, Chu Ka Chun, Fung Tsan Chung, Cho Chun Wa and Ip Siu Hang, whose project was titled "Damon and Pythias Friendships" (生死之交), received the Distinguished Prize in the Senior Section and was awarded a trophy, certificates and book coupons worth \$300. Moreover, Ki Mei Ying, Fu Man Chi, Lo Ka Wing and Sin Yuen Ting from S.4, whose project was titled "Development of Hong Kong Education from the Perspective of Numbers" (從數字看香港教育的發展), received the Distinguished Prize in the Junior Section and was awarded a trophy, certificates and book coupons worth \$300.
