

The 4th Yuen Long District Outstanding Primary School Students Award (2009/2010)
Prize-giving Ceremony



The 4th Yuen Long District Outstanding Primary School Students Award prize-giving ceremony was successfully held on 17th April, 2010 in N.T. Heung Yee Kuk Yuen Long District Secondary School. The ceremony was graced by the presence of Prof. Thomas WONG Kwok-shing, Vice President (Management) of the Hong Kong Polytechnic University.
