

Outstanding Student Leaders Selection 2010-2011



The Hok Yau Club Potential Development Centre has organized the “Outstanding Secondary School Student Leaders Selection 2010-2011” to recognize and award S.4 to S.7 student leaders who have shown remarkable levels of responsibility and contribution to their schools and society. After three rounds of interviews, S.6 Lee Yan Ho Hosea and S.4 Lee Oi Yan Sera were short-listed to be two of the initial thirty student leaders. After the final round of interviews, Hosea Lee was ultimately selected as one of ten Outstanding Secondary School Student Leaders.

The thirty student leaders who passed the first three rounds of interviews were invited to attend a series of leadership training programmes from February to April that culminated in a 7-day exchange trip. During the programmes, not only did the student leaders have to plan and execute a poll on the opinions of secondary school students and other society related activities, they also had the opportunity to meet leaders from different areas of Hong Kong and take part in an exchange trip to the Xi’an to develop a greater understanding of Hong Kong and our motherland. Through a string of experiential learning activities, participating students were able to further mature and raise their personal qualities.
