

'Sichuan Earthquake Disaster' Mourning Activities



The Sichuan earthquake disaster pulls at everyone's heartstrings all over the world and it is part of life education as well as national education. A three-day mourning period starting from 18th May, 2008 to 20th May, 2008 was announced.

The mourning activities held by our school included:

- Display boards showing the photos and news clippings of the cause and dimensions of the disaster
- The Campus TV Team was responsible for showing the latest news of the disaster during lunchtime
- A three-minute silence was observed on 19th May, 2008 at 2:28 p.m. (exactly a week after the quake struck)
- The national flag were flown at half-mast during the mourning period
- Donation (HK\$120,051) collected from all stakeholders was credited into the Hong Kong Red Cross bank account
- Students offered their condolences and spiritual support to the earthquake victims by writing blessings cards
