Commencement of 2022/23 School Year

Commencement of our school's 2022/23 School Year was successfully held on-site and through live broadcast online on Thursday, 1 September 2022.

Principal YUEN first led all teaching staff and students to attend the flag-raising ceremony. He then gave a speech and expressed his pleasure to see everyone at school. He called for students to maintain good health and strong anti-epidemic awareness and receive the third dose of vaccine as soon as possible. In total, 110 students (88.7%) have met the general entrance requirements for local undergraduate university programmes. 6E WONG Pak-ching, Janice and YU Tung-ching, our top scorers, achieved outstanding results with level 5** across 6 subjects. 6E MA Yixuan and CHENG Chun-wai have been admitted to Tsinghua University whereas 6E LUI Ka-nam has been admitted to Peking University. Principal YUEN expressed his gratitude to all teachers for their concerted effort in discovering and developing students' full potential. He also encouraged S.6 students to continue to strive for excellence in the coming public examination.

To cultivate Heung Chung students to be prominent and responsible members in the community, Principal YUEN announced the two major concerns of this year's school development: optimizing learning and teaching strategies to enhance the learning effectiveness of students and promoting students' wellness by nurturing their positive outlook in life. A wide range of activities and programmes are going to be held in line with the main theme 'Be Grateful, Be Proactive, Be Optimistic' as well as the theme of our 55th Anniversary 'Forge Ahead Compassion • Dedication • Innovation'. Principal YUEN also introduced the new policy where students can bring their electronic communication devices to classrooms.

In the previous years, Principal YUEN encouraged students to be resilient and contribute to society with letters A, B, C and D. This year, Principal YUEN motivated students to explore their potential with three 'E's'. He encouraged students to have more 'Exploration' in life and make 'Engagement' while devoting determined 'Effort' in achieving excellence and creating a bright future.
