Being selected as one of the 40 participants out of 300 student applicants, Hoi-yi had the great opportunity of job-shadowing Mr WONG Kam-sing, Secretary for the Environment, on 17 August 2021.

The programme offers selected students (S3-S6) an opportunity to shadow a senior government official for a day, gaining hands-on experience of an official's work and a better understanding of the Government's operation. It also aims at providing officials a chance to share with students their work experience while learning about students' insights on different issues, their life goals and future plans.
