

## Exploration Tour on Dongjiang Water Supply to Hong Kong (20-21 February 2025)

Our school participated in the ‘Exploration Tour on Dongjiang Water Supply to Hong Kong’ jointly organized by the Education Bureau, Development Bureau, and Water Supplies Department from 20 February (Thursday) to 21 February 2025 (Friday). The activity was led by the Assistant Principal Ms. KWAN Ki-shun who accompanied 10 students from Secondary 2 to Secondary 4 on a study tour to Shenzhen and Dongguan in Guangdong Province. Through the exploration tour, students gained insights into the history and current status of the Dongjiang water supplied to Hong Kong, learned about the Dongjiang-Shenzhen Water Supply Project, and explored the operation of the Dongjiang water supply system to Hong Kong. Through the tour, students have recognized the impact of human activities on the ecological environment and gained a deeper understanding of the necessity of safeguarding ecological and resource security.

On 20 February, students visited Dongguan City where they toured the Taiyuan Pumping Station. They observed the raw water quality at the intake point for Dongjiang water supplied to Hong Kong and learned about the large-scale infrastructure projects in place to monitor the water quality of Dongjiang. On the following day, 21 February, students visited the Memorial Park of the Dongjiang-Shenzhen Water Supply Project in Dongguan City and went to the exhibition hall to explore the history of the project and its importance to Hong Kong’s water supply. They also participated in a thematic seminar on water resources for gaining insights into the Pearl River Delta Water Resources Allocation Project and water saving measures. During an interactive session, students conducted simple water quality tests which helped them understand the high standards required for Dongjiang water supplied to Hong Kong and the rigorous efforts made by our country to ensure water quality. In addition, students visited the Nanshan Museum and Nantou Ancient City where they explored the historical, cultural and economic development of Nanshan. They experienced in person the recent developments in the Greater Bay Area and learned about the revitalization of historical buildings and the conservation of cultural heritage. The visit also deepened the students’ understanding of the local economy and community activities
