

Tuen Ng Festival Rice Dumpling Workshop

(6 May, 8 May, 9 May and 13 May 2025)

To promote traditional Chinese food culture, the Citizenship and Social Development Department of our school organized a Tuen Ng Festival Rice Dumpling Workshop in May 2025 for all S.4 students.

During the workshop, students had the opportunity to taste rice dumplings. Under the guidance of professional instructors, they learnt how to make two types of Hakka rice dumplings – peanut-flavored and green bean-flavored – and took them home to share with their families. They also explored the differences between Guangdong style and Hakka-style rice dumpling, deepening their understanding and curiosity about Chinese culture.
