Other Learning Experiences (OLE) – Service Learning

(6 February 2025 to 21 May 2025)

To foster students' generic skills, positive values, and attitudes through experiential learning, the Other Learning Experiences Team and the Social Services Team collaborated to provide valuable learning opportunities in OLE lessons.

Three training sessions were conducted for all S4 students to prepare them for community visits, where they served diverse groups in need under the guidance of social workers from Yuen Long Town Hall. As they advanced to S5, an additional leadership and project management training session further honed their skills. Through these initiatives, students applied classroom knowledge in real-world settings while demonstrating care and compassion for marginalized groups in society.

On 25 February 2025 (Tuesday) and 21 May 2025 (Wednesday), all S5 and S4 students respectively engaged in service-learning activities. They designed customized service plans, prepared tailored materials, and refined their communication skills to better connect with the community. These experiences not only strengthened their generic skills but also deepened their empathy and commitment to social responsibility. Overall, the programme provided a meaningful and transformative learning journey for all participants.
