## **Achieving Outstanding Results Across All Years**

Having attained 5\*\* in 6 subjects, CHAN Cheuk-lai was invited to meet the Permanent Secretary for Education, Ms. CHAN Wing-shiu, May, JP

130 of our students took part in 2025 Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination and got excellent results with a total haul of **320 Level 5 or above** and **570 Level 4 or above**, which are equal to **43.1%** and **76.8%** of the total number of subjects sat respectively. In total, 117 students (90%) have met the general entrance requirements (levels 332A22 in core subjects and 2 electives) for local undergraduate university programmes.
