Chongqing and Chengdu Study Tour

(26 June to 30 June 2025)

From 26 June 2025 (Thursday) to 30 June 2025 (Monday), 30 S3 to S5 students, accompanied by teachers Ms. LEUNG Nga-yi, Mr. CHOY Kim-wah and Mr. LAM Fai-chun embarked on a study tour to Chongqing and Chengdu.

The study tour provided students with opportunities to explore Chongqing's distinctive geographical environment through visits to the Yangtze River Cableway Scenic Area and Hongya Cave. It enabled them to learn about the city's historical development by touring Kuixing Tower and Liberation Monument, as well as watching the stage play *Chongqing 1949*. Through visits to the Huguang Guild Hall, Chongqing Planning Exhibition Hall, and Beicang Cultural and Creative Block, students examined Chongqing's urban development and gained insights into local life, strengthening their sense of national identity and cultural belonging.

Subsequently, the study tour proceeded to Chengdu, where students visited the Du Fu Thatched Cottage to appreciate the patriotic spirit and benevolence of the renowned Tang Dynasty poet Du Fu. They then explored Jinli Ancient Street, a famous historical and cultural district in Chengdu. At the Chengdu Research Base of Giant Panda Breeding, students observed the living habits of giant pandas, deepening their understanding of China's conservation efforts.

This study tour broadened our students' horizons, allowing them to experience the local culture of Chongqing and Chengdu. It enriched their understanding of our country's history and culture, strengthened their sense of national identity, and fostered patriotism.
