

80th Anniversary of the Victory in the War of Resistance Series -
Historical and Cultural Exploration Tour of Nanjing and Beijing
(10-15 November 2025)

From 10 November 2025 (Monday) to 15 November 2025 (Saturday), 10 S3-4 students from our school, led by Assistant Principal Mr. LO Wai-yan, participated in the ‘80th Anniversary of Victory in the War of Resistance - Historical and Cultural Exploration Tour of Nanjing and Beijing’, organized by the Education Bureau. A total of 44 teachers and students from four secondary schools took part in this study tour.

During the six-day tour, students visited several sites and museums related to the Chinese People’s War of Resistance against Japanese Aggression (War of Resistance), including the Hongse Li Xiang and the Memorial Hall of Nanjing Anti-Japanese Aviation Martyrs in Nanjing, as well as the Museum of the War of Chinese People’s Resistance Against Japanese Aggression, the Lugou Bridge, the Museum of the Communist Party of China, and the Beijing Jiaozhuanghu Underground Tunnel Museum in Beijing. The schedule also included a lecture at Nanjing University on the topic of ‘The National Mobilization Against Japan and the Patriotism of Hong Kong Compatriots’. These activities helped students gain a deeper understanding of the history of the War of Resistance and the significant contributions of the Communist Party of China during this period. Additionally, by introducing the moving stories of war heroes and arranging participation in commemorative activities for the martyrs, the study tour could boost their patriotism and determination to contribute to the nation.

In addition, the itinerary for the students included visits to several cultural and commercial sites, such as the East Zhonghua Gate Historical Culture Block and the Nanjing Confucius Temple Pedestrian Street in Nanjing, as well as the Moshikou Historical and Cultural Block, the Haifa Temple Mural Art Center and the Shougang Park in Shijingshan in Beijing. These visits allowed them to witness the achievements in cultural heritage conservation and the socio-economic landscape of our country. The students were also arranged to take a scenic boat ride on the Qinhuai River, watch cultural performances at the Lao She Teahouse, and participate in traditional Chinese knot-making and cloisonné workshops. These activities provided them with a relaxed and enjoyable atmosphere to personally experience traditional Chinese culture, deepening their understanding of China’s cultural heritage and enhancing their pride and confidence in traditional Chinese culture.

Finally, our students shared their insights and thoughts from the field trip with students from other schools in a sharing session on the 5th day of the trip. The event not only encouraged students from different schools to interact and learn from each other, but also helped reinforce the knowledge they gained during the trip and promote their reflection.

The study tour effectively enhanced our students’ understanding of the history of the War of Resistance and the importance of national security. Additionally, the event increased students’ awareness and interest in traditional Chinese culture, thereby boosting their cultural confidence.

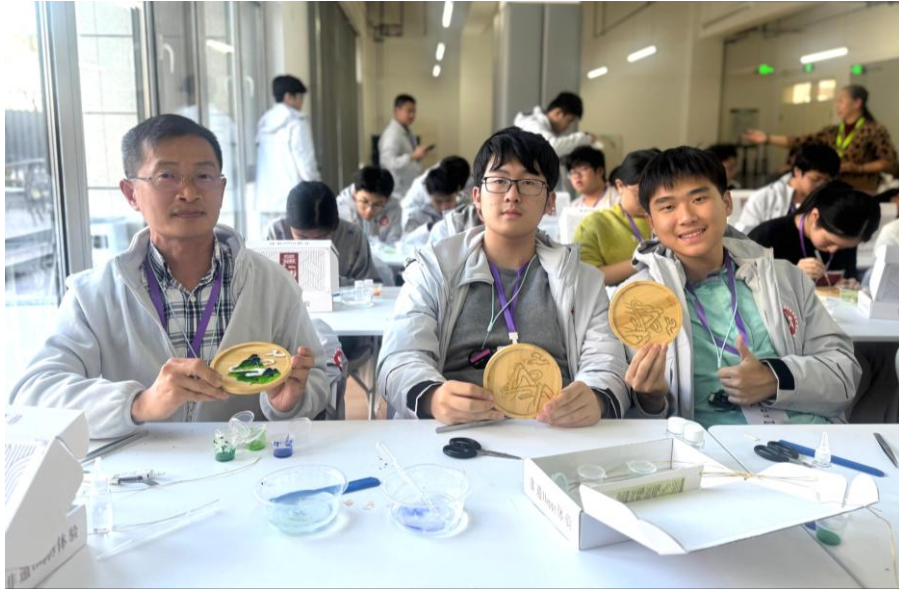
