On 22 March 2026 (Sunday), our Parents and Teachers Association held the Annual Spring Family Trip: Exploring Sha Tau Kok Restricted Area – Family Farm Day Tour. Afterwards, they visited the Sha Tau Kok Frontier Closed Area to explore Top 10 attractions, including the Fish Lantern Square, Sha Tau Kok Pier, and Chung Ying Street Garden, experiencing the natural scenery and historical culture. Subsequently, everyone enjoyed a traditional Hakka-style lunch. After lunch, the members continued their tour of Sha Tau Kok's unique architecture, including the vibrantly coloured public housing estates and the site of the old fire station.
