

The 13th Repatriation and Burial Ceremony
for the Remains of Chinese People's Volunteers Martyrs from South Korea
(19 April – 23 April 2026)

5A WAN Cheuk-ying was selected as a Hong Kong student representative to visit Shenyang and Dandong, Liaoning Province, from 19 April (Sunday) to 23 April 2026 (Thursday). During the trip, she attended the 13th Repatriation and Burial Ceremony for the remains of Chinese People's Volunteers martyrs and visited several red education landmarks.

At the repatriation ceremony held at Shenyang Taoxian International Airport, she witnessed honour guards escorting the martyrs' caskets slowly down from the special aircraft. The crowd stood in solemn silence and bowed, as the nation welcomed the heroes home with the highest honours in a deeply moving atmosphere. The following day, the burial ceremony at the Martyrs' Cemetery was equally solemn and dignified. Amid poignant music and a salute from the honour guards, the martyrs were laid to rest.

In addition to the core ceremonies, the delegation travelled to Dandong to visit the Yalu River Broken Bridge, the Memorial Hall of the War to Resist U.S. Aggression and Aid Korea, and the Dandong Warship. They also participated in a memorial service by the Yalu River and attended a theatrical ideological and political lesson at Eastern Liaoning University, deeply revisiting the glorious yet arduous history of the war.

Having personally experienced these stirring ceremonies, she felt deeply that today's national peace and prosperity stem entirely from the martyrs' sacrifices. She expressed that, as a youth of the new era, she would always remember history and carry forward the spirit of the martyrs. The school hopes this experience will deepen students' patriotism and national identity, inspiring all students to forge ahead with determination.
