

Xi'an Study Tour

(25 June – 29 June 2026)

From 25 June 2026 (Thursday) to 29 June 2026 (Monday), a group of 30 Secondary 1 to Secondary 5 students, accompanied by Ms. CHAU Linda, Ms. WONG Sze-wing, and Mr. WONG Ching-yu, participated in our school's Xi'an Study Tour. The tour allowed students to deeply explore the long-standing history of the motherland and experience its magnificent natural landscapes through a personal visit to Xi'an — an ancient capital spanning thirteen dynasties.

During the five-day itinerary, teachers and students visited various famous historical landmarks. Immediately upon arrival on the first day, the group toured the Xi'an City Wall, experiencing the profound cultural heritage of the ancient capital. In the days that followed, students visited historical scenic spots including Emperor Qinshihuang's Mausoleum Site Museum, Huaqing Pool, Da Ci'en Temple, the Giant Wild Goose Pagoda, the Xi'an Museum, the Small Wild Goose Pagoda, and the Han Yangling Museum. They also watched the breathtaking dance dramas *The Song of Everlasting Regret* and *The Legend of Camel Bells Show*, which made them feel as though they had travelled through time to experience the golden age of the Tang Dynasty and the legends of the Silk Road.

In addition to learning about rich national history and culture, students also embraced a demanding physical challenge by taking the West Peak Cableway up Mount Hua, one of the Five Great Mountains of China, to feast their eyes on the spectacular natural scenery. Furthermore, students strolled through Yongxingfang and Huimin Street, soaking up the vibrant market culture and the charm of intangible cultural heritage. On the final day, all teachers and students returned safely to Hong Kong by flight, carrying with them fruitful learning outcomes.

This Xi'an study tour not only enriched students' knowledge of and interest in national history and traditional culture but also broadened their horizons, boosted their cultural confidence, and strengthened their sense of national identity.
