

20th Singapore-Hong Kong Exchange Programme 2026

(22 – 28 July 2026)

Under the guidance of Ms. KWAN Ki-shun, Assistant Principal, 6 students of S2 successfully completed the 20th Singapore-Hong Kong Exchange Programme 2026 co-organized by the Singapore Ministry of Education and the Hong Kong Education Bureau from 22 July (Wednesday) to 28 July 2026 (Tuesday). The 7-day programme aimed to promote educational and cultural exchange, broaden students' international perspectives and cultivate an attitude of respect for cultural diversity.

With the theme 'Connecting Cultures, Nurturing Harmony', students from both places joined hands to create a meaningful chapter of cultural learning and build lasting friendships.
