To celebrate students’ learning achievements in AI technology, the Competition Commission and Junior Achievement Hong Kong co-organised the ‘Post to Compete’ Comic Creation Advocacy Challenge 2026 – Empowering Creativity with AI Award Presentation Ceremony on 26 August 2026 (Wednesday) to commend the winning schools and students.

Our students were **Finalists** in the Junior Secondary Category of the competition. **3A CHU Ham-ue** and **3A HO Yan-kiu Karia** collaborated to create an impressive comic that expressed their creative ideas through the use of artificial intelligence. Their team was shortlisted among the top eight teams in the **Junior Secondary Category** and received a HK\$1,000 cash scholarship.

The competition aims to provide secondary school students in Hong Kong with an opportunity to unleash their creativity by designing comic strips that promote the Competition Ordinance. Participants were also invited to attend a workshop in which a popular KOL and an illustrator shared tips on using AI in comic creation to produce attractive content, developing characters, and crafting compelling stories.
