

The Geography Field Study –
Wetland Encounter at Mai Po Nature Reserve



Thirty Eight junior form students joined a geography field study at Mai Po Nature Reserve organized by the geography teachers. The field study aimed to help students to understand the uniqueness of wetlands, especially in Mai Po Inner Deep Bay Ramsar Site. The concept of uniqueness of wetlands was delivered through different interactive activities, including word-guessing game and photo sharing. Various interpretations on wetland environment and wildlife were included to enrich students' understanding of the importance of wetlands and the problems being faced in Hong Kong. Students had a memorable experience in visiting the natural place in their district. They all actively participated in the field study.
